The characteristics of the organisation (main areas of educational activities, who are adult learners, etc.)	Bytom Educational Centre (Bytomski Ośrodek Edukacji – BOE) is a large public educational organization on regional level. Bytom Educational Centre was established on 1 September 2012 by the merger of two previously separate educational institutions: Center for Continuing Education in Bytom and Practical Training Centre in Bytom. The Centre offers education to learners aged from 16 and over. Each year, 600 juvenile students, 1,200 adults and 500 seniors receive education and take courses in it. Centre employs 140 teachers, vocational teachers and trainers and 40 administrative and technical staff. Centre for Continuing Education in Bytom (Centrum Kształcenia Ustawicznego – CKU Bytom) - was established in 1982 and is engaged in general and vocational education of adults. Within CCE there are schools for adults, and the University of the Third Age. The Centre also runs training courses for people interested in gaining new professional skills or continuing their education. The Centre cooperates with local businesses, labor offices, social welfare centers and prisons. Bytom University of the Third Age (Bytomski Uniwersytet Trzeciego Wieku – BUTW) - was established in 2006. The University provides education and activities to meet needs of the elderly. Every year the University organizes lectures for seniors (literature, history, medicine, economics, culture,), courses of foreign languages (English, German, French, Italian and Russian), ICT trainings, recreational activities (gymnastics, swimming, Nordic Walking, aerobics) and interest groups (choir, theater, painting, arts and crafts, cooking).
