PART I: GENERAL INFORMATION

• DESCRIPTION OF TOWN

- SHORT HISTORY AND LOCATION

PATRAS WAS FOUNDED BY THE ACHAEANS, PREUGENES AND PATREUS MADE THREE IONIAN MARKET TOWNS INTO ONE, THOSE THREE WERE AROE, MESATI AND ANTHEIA AND HAVING AS CENTER AROE THEY FOUNDED A NEW CITY THAT THEY CALLED PATRES AFTER PATREUS. PATRAS IS FIRSTLY INHABITED IN THE 3^{RD} . MILLENIUM B.C., BUT IT STARTED FLOURISHING FOR ITS FIRST TIME DURING THE POST-HELLENISTIC OR MYCENEAN PERIOD (1580-1100 B.C.). HOWEVER, IT REACHED ITS HIGHEST PEAK DURING THE ROMAN PERIOD WHEN ITS PORT, BECAUSE OF THE DESTRUCTION OF CORINTH'S PORT, PLAYED THE FIRST ROLE IN THE COMMUNICATION OF GREECE WITH ITALY. SINCE THE 13TH CENTURY, IT BELONGS SOMETIMES TO THE FRANKS, SOMETIMES TO THE VENETIANS AND SOME OTHER TIMES TO THE TURKS. AFTER THE LIBERATION FROM THE TURKS, PATRAS DEVELOPS FAST, THANKS TO ITS PORT AND THE COMMERCE THAT TAKES PLACE THROUGH IT. BEAUTIFUL NEO-CLASSIC BUILDINGS EMBELLISH THE CITY WHOSE ROADS ALL END UP TO THE SEA, SO THAT ITS BRACING FORCE IS NOT CUT. ARTISTIC AND SPIRITUAL LIFE IS VERY INTENSE. GRADUALLY THE HEAVY INDUSTRY DEVELOPS, WHICH HAS AS A RESULT THE RISE OF THE POPULATION. TODAY, PATRAS IS ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT CITIES IN GREECE AND ITS PORT IS STILL PLAYING THAT IMPORTANT ROLE THAT IT HAD DURING ALL ITS LONG HISTORY. THE MUNICIPALITY OF PATRAS SUSPENDS ITS FATE, ECONOMY, CULTURE AND STRATEGIC UPON CONSTANT COMMUNICATION WITH THE WEST, FOR CENTURIES, THROUGH THE SEA PORT OF PATRAS. NOWADAYS PATRAS IS A FINANCIAL, ADMINISTRATIVE AND CULTURAL CENTER OF THE AREA. IT IS BUILT ON PANACHAIKO'S MOUNTAIN FOOTHILLS AND IS SITUATED AT THE CENTER OF 4 MAJOR ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES: ANCIENT OLYMPIA, DELPHI, EPIDAURUS AND MYCENAE. PATRA'S PORT IS GREECE'S GATE TO THE WEST AND ONE OF THE MAJOR PORTS OF MEDITERRANEAN SEA, TOURING THE AREA SHOULD START FROM THE CAPITAL OF ACHAIA, PATRA, PATRA, IS THE THIRD, CITY IN POPULATION IN GREECE. IT COMBINES EXCEPTIONAL NATURAL BEAUTY, A LONG HISTORY AND UNIQUE SIGHTS, NEVER BORING ITS VISITORS. ACHAIA IS BLESSED WITH A MILD CLIMATE, FERTILE LAND, AND MONUMENTS OF GREAT CULTURAL VALUE. THE CITY OF PATRA, WITH APPROXIMATELY 250,000 INHABITANTS NOWADAYS, ATTRACTS A GREAT NUMBER OF GREEK AND FOREIGN VISITORS EVERY YEAR. THE LUCKY ONES WHO TASTE THE WARM HOSPITALITY OF THE CITY, ARE UNWILLING TO LEAVE, PATRA OFFERS ITS VISITORS A LOT OF OPPORTUNITIES FOR ENTERTAINMENT, SHORT TRIPS AND REST FOR THOSE APPRECIATING A MORE RELAXED PACE OF LIFE. PATRA HAS LARGE CONVENTION CENTRES, THEATRES, MUSEUMS, SITES FOR ORGANIZING COMMERCIAL EXHIBITIONS, SPORTS FACILITIES THAT ATTRACT EUROPEAN AND WORLD ATHLETIC MEETINGS, A RICH CULTURAL LIFE, THE ANNUAL INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL AND THE FAMOUS CARNIVAL OF PATRA. TOURISTS ARE FASCINATED BY THE NARROW STREETS OF THE OLD CITY AND THE BUILDINGS OF NEO-CLASSIC ARCHITECTURAL STYLE, REVEALING THE OLD GRANDEUR OF THE CITY, PATRA IS A CITY OF UNIQUE BEAUTY AND HISTORY.

- MAIN LOCAL/CULTURAL EVENTS

Patra is not only a significant Greek and international port. It is a historical but at the same time dynamically contemporary Greek city, of great interest for visitors, that is in addition surrounded by an exciting inland. The city, the byzantine castle crowning it, to the Rio-Antirio bridge that stretches to the opposite shore, harmonically incorporates its daily rhythms with its recent history, its dynamic and youthful present, (40.000 students) and its promising future. The city is characterised by a broad spectrum of interests, ranging from pious faith in the Apostle Andreas, to the wild enthusiasm of the Patra Carnival.

Patra is also the starting point, for trips to the beaches of the Patra and Corinthian gulfs, to the peaks of the three imposing Achaean mountains, to the hiking trails and their various pistes (skiing, climbing, parachuting), to the historical monasteries, to traditional and neoclassical architecture, the charming city of Aigio and the historical but also touristic resort of Kalavrita.

Sights

The Roman Conservatoire

It was built in 160 A.D., covered by earth throughout the centuries, was discovered in 1889, and restored in 1952, ever since when it hosts summer cultural events (seats about 2000 spectators). Sarcophagi and mosaics are on display in the surrounding area.

- HOW TO REACH TOWN (LINKS FROM THE NEAREST AIRPORT, TRAIN OR COACH STATIONS)

BY AIR

PATRAS IS CONNECTED BY AIR MAINLY THROUGH THE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OF ATHENS. THE AIRPORT OF ARAXOS (ABOUT 30 km. West of patras) is also used for charter flights.

How do I get to Patra? **Patra is served by** domestic and international flights by the Araxos Airport, located 45kms from Patra.

There are flight to and from Herakleion (Crete) and Thessalonica as well as International charter flights (especially during the summer months).

Patra is located 216 kilometres west of Athens, on the north-western coast of Peloponnese, at the foot of the Panachaiko mountain and on the coast of the Gulf of Patra.



By Car:

From Athens via the Korinthos/Patra National Road:

Driving from Athens take the Korinthos/Patra National Road.

Upon entering Patra (1st exit after the tolls), stay on the right lane that heads to the Centre of Patra, Port.

The distance from Athens to Patra is approximately 216 kilometres.

From the Athens International Airport Eleftherios Venizelos:

Upon leaving the Athens International Airport drive along the "Attiki Odos" headed to Elefsina.

Upon exiting the "Attiki Odos" highway you find yourselves on the national road towards Korinthos/Patra. If you wish to travel by public transport from the Athens International Airport, board the Express Line bus E93 from outside the airport's main building (gates 4-5) and get off at the Kifisos Interurban Bus Station.

Patra is connected to **Sterea Ellada** by the Rio-Antirio Bridge.

BY TRAIN

THERE ARE DAILY SERVICES TO AND FROM ATHENS AS WELL AS ALL THE MAJOR OFFSHORE CITIES OF THE PELOPONNESE. THE TRIP TO ATHENS LASTS ABOUT 3.5 HOURS, BY THE INTERCITY EXPRESS TRAIN. THE TRAIN STATION (OSE) IS LOCATED IN THE TOWN CENTER, NEAR THE HARBOUR AND THE COACH STATION. Patra is connected by rail to Athens and Piraeus as well as to Pyrgos and Kalamata.

If you board the train from Piraeus/Kiato (proastiakos) you will need to change at Kiato.

BY COACH

PATRAS IS LINKED WITH THE CAPITAL CITY OF ATHENS WITH REGULAR COACH SERVICES, EVERY 30 MINUTES (IT TAKES ABOUT 2.5 HOURS TO REACH THE CAPITAL). THERE ARE ALSO DAILY COACH SERVICES TO ALL MAJOR CITIES OF GREECE, THE IONIAN ISLANDS AND THE WELL-KNOWN ARCHAEOLOGICAL SITES. THE COACH STATION (KTEL) IS LOCATED AT THE CENTER OF PATRAS, AT 2 ZAIMI STR. AND OTHONOS AMALIAS STR. The New Patra-Pyrgos National Road leads to Pyrgos, Ancient Olympia, Kyllini

(from where you can board the ferry for Kefallonia, Ithaki, Zakynthos) and also to Kalamata.

- TRANSPORT IN TOWN (BRIEF INFORMATION ON THE MAIN MEANS OF TRANSPORT AVAILABLE)

CITY BUS - TAXI

THERE IS A DENSE NETWORK OF CITY BUSES, WHICH LINKS THE CENTER OF PATRAS WITH ALL AREAS OF THE CITY AND ITS SUBURBS.

THERE ARE, ALSO, ABOUT 1000 TAXIS IN PATRAS, AVAILABLE AROUND THE CLOCK.

• SHORT DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANISING INSTITUTION

THE TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTE OF PATRAS WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1970 AS A CENTER OF PROFESSIONAL TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION (K.A.T.E.). TODAY, WITH THE APPLICATION OF LAW 2916/2001, T.E.I OF PATRAS BELONGS TO THE HIGHER EDUCATION. THE INSTITUTES OF THE TECHNOLOGICAL SECTOR EMPHASIZE THE TRAINING OF STAFF IN HIGH QUALITY APPLICATIONS. THERE ARE 11 DEPARTMENTS THAT BELONG TO THE THREE FACULTIES. FROM THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2003-2004, THERE ARE 3 NEW INDEPENDENT DEPARTMENTS THAT BELONG TO THE T.E.I OF PATRAS. THE T.E.I DEPARTMENTS AWARD AN UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE THAT IS VALID FOR ENTRANCE TO POST-GRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMS IN BOTH GREEK AND FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES. T.E.I ALSO RUNS POSTGRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMS. THESE PROGRAMS ARE ORGANIZED IN CONNECTION WITH UNIVERSITIES AT HOME AND ABROAD. THE T.E.I OF PATRAS IS LOCATED IN A QUIET AND PLEASANT AREA, STANDING OVER 100 HECTARES, ONLY 4 KM. FROM THE CITY CENTER. THE PALM TREES AND CEDARS MAKE IT AN IDEAL PLACE FOR LONG WALKS AND FOR RELAXING. THE BUILDINGS OCCUPY 54,000 SQUARE METRES. IN THE T.E.I CAMPUS IS THE T.E.I STUDENT CLUB, CHARGED WITH THE BOARD AND LODGING, THE MEDICAL, PHARMACEUTICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE OF THE STUDENTS. THE PHILOSOPHY OF THE T.E.I IS TO CATER FOR CONTEMPORARY EDUCATIONAL NEEDS. SUBSEQUENTLY, A GREAT DEAL OF ATTENTION IS PAID TO FOREIGN LANGUAGES. THE CENTER OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION CONSTITUTES AN EDUCATIONAL UNIT AT T.E.I LEVEL. CONSEQUENTLY, A NUMBER OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES, MAINLY FROM THE E.U MEMBER STATES, ARE CURRENTLY BEING TAUGHT AT THE T.E.I., WITH NEW PROGRAMS EMPHASIZING THE TERMINOLOGY OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES. THERE ARE FIVE FOREIGN LANGUAGE LABORATORIES OPERATING AT THE T.E.I, FULLY EQUIPPED WITH MODERN TECHNOLOGIES AND FOREIGN LANGUAGE MATERIAL, AS WELL AS LECTURE ROOMS FOR THIS PURPOSE. THE T.E.I. LIBRARY CONTAINS 20,000 VOLUMES OF BOOKS AND 200 CURRENT MAGAZINE TITLES. IT PROVIDES ACCESS FOR ITS USERS THROUGH THE HELLENIC ACADEMIC LIBRARIES NETWORK TO 3.500 ELECTRONIC MAGAZINES, WITH FULL TEXT, IT ALSO PROVIDES FREE INTERNET ACCESS FOR ITS USERS. The conference center occupies an area of 25000 square meters and contains a large and a small amphitheatre, CONFERENCE AND SEMINAR ROOMS AND SPACE FOR MULTIPLE USES, AS WELL AS A PUBLIC RECEPTION AREA. ALL AREAS ARE EQUIPPED WITH STATE OF THE ART AUDIOVISUAL AND TRANSLATION SYSTEMS. THE KOLLA VILLA IS A NOTABLE EXAMPLE OF A LATE 19TH CENTURY MANOR AND BOASTS IMPORTANT WORKS OF DATING BACK TO 1830. THE CHURCH OF THE THREE HIERARCHS, BUILT IN A BYZANTINE STYLE IS DECORATED WITH INTERIOR WOODEN CARVINGS AND BOASTS EXTERIOR STONE WORK FROM IOANNINA AND PARAMYTHIA. OTHER SERVICES INCLUDE THE TECHNOLOGICAL RESEARCH CENTER OF PATRAS, A SELF GOVERNING INSTITUTE, TELEMATICS, RADIO, TELEVISION STATION, SPEECH THERAPY CLINIC AND A STANDARD LABORATORY FOR PRESCHOOL EDUCATION, AS WELL AS A NETWORK MANAGEMENT CENTER. THE T.E.I. PARTICIPATES IN MANY EUROPEAN EDUCATIONAL AND RESEARCH PROJECTS AND HAS INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGES AND COOPERATION WITH A SUBSTANTIAL NUMBER OF UNIVERSITIES THROUGHOUT EUROPE. WITHIN ITS PRESENT EUROPEAN POLICY THE T.E.I INTENDS TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF INCOMING ERASMUS STUDENTS, WHICH UP TO NOW AMOUNTS TO ABOUT 45 IN WESTERN GREECE. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED WITH THE ORGANIZATION OF GREEK LESSONS AND DISSEMINATION OF THE GREEK CULTURE. THE CULTURAL ACTIVITIES AND EVENTS WHICH WILL BE ORGANIZED BY THE CENTER OF FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION, AS WELL AS SUPPORT FROM THE CAREER OFFICE WILL SERVE THIS PURPOSE.

IN MOST OF THE APARTMENTS THERE ARE COOKING FACILITIES. BESIDES, THE EILC ORGANISING COMMITTEE MAKES EFFORTS TO SECURE 2 FREE MEALS PER DAY IN THE TEI RESTAURANT.

MEALS WILL BE PROVIDED TO THE STUDENTS AT THE T.E.I RESTAURANT, AT A MINIMAL CHARGE OF 5,50 EUROS PER DAY (3 MEALS INCLUDED), DURING THE ACADEMIC PERIOD.
